The final project for this class is a website created using neocities.org. Feel free to work on this project at home. However, you should be able to complete it just during class time as long as you stay on task.

Grading Rubric

A - This website consists of at least **five** linked pages, contains well-formatted html and css, and demonstrates a good usage of the techniques we've been using in class. **Your website contains an index, a page about HTML, a page about CSS, and a page about this class.**

B - This website consists of **five** linked pages, contains few html and css errors, and demonstrates a good usage of the techniques we've been using in class. **Your website contains an index, a page about HTML, a page about CSS, and a page about this class.**

C - This website consists of at least four linked pages, contains several html and css errors, and demonstrates basic knowledge of the techniques we've been using in class. **Your website contains an index, and two or more of: a page about HTML, a page about CSS, and a page about this class.**

D - This website consists of less than four linked pages, contains many html and css errors, and demonstrates a lack of knowledge of the techniques we've been using in class. **Your website contains zero or one of the required pages.**

Grading Details

- A "linked page" is an HTML page that is accessible via <a> links from the home page.
- Well-formatted html and css has no errors, extra tags, etc. HTML should not be inside the CSS and vice versa.
- The techniques you **must** demonstrate are:
 - Hexadecimal colors (e.g. #FF6600;)
 - The css rules color, background-colors, background image, background-repeat
 - The html tags <p>, <a>, <h1> and other headers, , and
 - Every page must have a proper doctype
 - Your HTML must not have missing tags or extra tags. Every HTML start tag must have a corresponding end tag
 - CSS rules must be valid and properly formatted

- Your site must contain the following pages.
 - **The index page** should be an index or introduction to the site.
 - **A page about HTML** should describe in your own words what HTML is.
 - **A page about CSS** should describe in your own words what CSS is.
 - **A page about this class** should be a reflection on this class, specifically the web development unit.
 - **A personal page** which can be whatever you want
 - You are encouraged to have more than just these pages!
- Do not copy existing material to create these pages. Your descriptions of HTML, CSS and your reflections on this class must be in your own words.
 - **If we find that you have copied material for these pages you will get an F on this assignment.**

Due Date and Details

- Websites will be graded on Jan 23rd at 8:50am. **There will be no extensions** - grades are due to the school district on the 23rd and we cannot grant you extra time.
- Turn in your website by simply making sure that all of your work is saved and that Robert and Erty have your URL (e.g. "<http://teals-test.neocities.org>"). We have a list and you need to make sure we have your website properly. **If we do not have the address of your website you will receive a zero on this assignment.**
- We will provide feedback and a grade by the end of day on the 23rd.
